CONFLICT MINERALS POLICY STATEMENT

Superlum achieves business objectives and customer needs while maintaining our company core values with integrity and social responsibility. To that end, we do not support or contribute to the violence and human rights violations associated with the mining of conflict minerals from the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Angola, Burundi, the Central African Republic, The Republic of Congo, Uganda, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania and Zambia.

Conflict Minerals are:

- columbite-tantalite, also known as coltan (tantalum);
- cassiterite (tin);
- gold;
- wolframite (tungsten);
- their derivatives;
- any other mineral or its derivatives determined by the Secretary of State to be financing conflict in the DRC Countries.

We continually survey our supply chain and currently **NO** confirmed “Conflict Minerals” are used in our supply chain. When possible, our suppliers’ conflict mineral statements are reviewed and maintained in our records.

We do not directly purchase Conflict Minerals from any source and do not knowingly procure any product containing Conflict Minerals from Conflict Regions. We encourage our suppliers to adopt similar policies and management systems with respect to Conflict Minerals and to drive similar efforts throughout their supply chain to ensure that the specified minerals are being sourced only from mines and smelters outside the “Conflict Region” or those within that have been certified by an independent third party as “conflict free”.
